### JOB DESCRIPTION

#### Education and qualifications:

##### Required:

- Licensed nurse

#### Experience and knowledge:

- Blood sample drawing experience
- CRD management experience
- English language: user knowledge

#### Main responsibilities and duties:

This clinical research nurse will work collaboratively with physicians, Clinical Research Associates (CRA) and pharmacists to coordinate care for an assigned population of patients who will be enrolled in clinical research trials in the context of two European Projects (Carbalive / Liver Hope)

- Trial tasks: identification of candidate subjects, trial procedures (blood sample drawing, ECG), completion of CRD etc.
- Responsible to assure that the documentation for the clinical trial is completed, and evaluation of processes to improve and advance clinical research are conducted.
- Participation in trial meetings (national or international).
- Assist in the assessment, management and coordination of care across the continuum of care.

- Educate patients and families on the clinical trial treatments and required testing.
